Effective immediately, submit pre-certification requests for treatment on the New Attending Provider Treatment Plan Form (attached). You can also download the PDF and Excel version of the Form by visiting DOBI's website <http://www.state.nj.us/dobi/pipinfo/aicrapg.htm>. Pursuant to DOBI's Order Number A16-01 (attached), pre-certification requests on the old Attending Provider Treatment Plan Form will not be valid after April 15, 2016. If you submit the treatment request on the old Attending Provider Treatment Plan Form after April 15, 2016, the insurance carrier will most likely access a 50% pre-certification penalty. Please start using the new form.

IT APPEARING that on September 24, 2004, the Department issued Order A04-143 establishing a uniform Attending Provider Treatment Plan (“AFTP”) form for providers to use to submit treatment and testing requests to insurers under the Personal Injury Protection (“PIP”) coverage of automobile insurance; and


IT FURTHER APPEARING that the implementation of the tenth revision of the International Statistical Classification of Diseases and Related Health Problems (“ICD-10”) necessitates changes to the AFTP; and

IT FURTHER APPEARING that the Department has made other minor changes to the AFTP form to improve the collection of necessary information;

THEREFORE, IT IS on this 9<sup>th</sup> day of February, 2016,

ORDERED that:

On or before April 15, 2016, the revised Attending Provider Treatment Plan form, attached as Appendix A to this Order, shall be used by all providers to submit Decision Point Review and Precertification Requests. No other forms for this purpose are permitted. Insurer and PIP vendors are encouraged to program the form on their websites so that it can be downloaded, completed and printed by the provider.
